Auction 2021

The 2021 Auction, *Together Wherever We Are*, is a Fun-raiser and Fundraiser all in one! It is our second year to hold the Auction online. Through the Auction offerings provided by our generous members and local businesses, you will find opportunities to **create community and celebrate life.** We bond both in fellowship and support UUCWC financially, always mindful of our eight principles and our declared purposes as a congregation.

AUCTION PROCEEDS HELP US FULFILL OUR MISSION

Our annual Auction supports all that we hope to achieve in the coming years. Auction proceeds are a

significant source of funding for UUCWC's annual operating budget. And if there is a surplus of auction revenues after meeting the targeted budget amount, 50% of that surplus will be donated to a social justice program selected by the Council for Faith in Action. This year's recipient will be the Bucks County Opportunity Council, a nonprofit dedicated to reducing poverty and promoting economic self-sufficiency while serving as the county's lead food

This program book is your guide to the many wonderful services, workshops, physical items, meals, custom food delivery and special events included in our 2021 Auction. *There is something for everyone, at every price point*. While some

items may require rescheduling or will be reimagined as "virtual" or video events, we encourage buyers and sellers alike to be flexible in these challenging circumstances and follow social distancing guidelines to ensure our health and safety. With your support we can achieve so much! And if you are a new member, we extend a special invitation to you and hope that you will participate in the many auction events.

ITEM CATEGORIES

RAISE A PADDLE TO SUPPORT THE AUCTION FUND (FIRST ITEM, #100)

While there is no registration fee, you can donate to UUCWC's Auction and "raise a paddle" to help defray costs and meet our financial goals. At live auctions, the paddle is raised for bidding. While we won't have an auctioneer to see your bid, select item #100 and choose your donation amount.

As in previous years, there are two main types of items:

- **Fixed-Price**, which includes meals, some custom foods, and events
- Competitive Bidding, which includes services, workshops, physical items, and gift cards to local businesses.

FIXED-PRICE PURCHASES (100s, 200s, 300s) BUY NOW

All fixed price items are purchased at the stated price, not through competitive bidding. Certificates will be issued to buyers, and donors will be notified of all the successful buyers.

101–199: themed meals in UUCWC members' homes or hosted at local restaurants. Meals are among the most popular auction offerings, and often go quickly.

Note: To make these items accessible to more people, we ask that, for the first day of the online auction, each household purchase no more than two meals in this category. After that, please log back in and purchase as many as you like through May 8!

200–299: events, delivered food and fixed-priced services. No limitations on purchasing.

300–399: events with 20 or more spaces. No limitations on purchasing.

Note: You must complete the purchase of each fixed-price item separately. It only takes a few seconds. **You cannot fill a "cart" of fixed-price items.** For each item you purchase, you will immediately receive a confirming email.

COMPETITIVE BIDDING (400s, 500s, 600s, 700s)

Here is where you get a chance to outbid others and win the item. Check back often throughout the week to see if you have been out bid and to enter a new bid.

400–499: services (such as handyman), custom food delivery, memberships or tickets to cultural events, special trips and more. The winning bidder will receive a certificate from the UUCWC Auction Team, and item fulfillment will be arranged with the donor.

500–599: physical items such as hand-crafted tables, jewelry, theme baskets and more.

While we cannot display items in person this year, you will see photos of the items online. After the online bidding closes, the Auction Team will facilitate the exchange of the item from donor to winning bidder.

600–699: gift cards for food, many of which were donated by local businesses.

700–799: gift cards for services or items, many of which were donated by local business.

Note: At the end of the Auction, you will receive an email confirmation of each competitive bid item you have won.

TAKE THE FIRST STEP AND PRE-REGISTER

Beginning on Saturday, April 17, you can preregister through this link to the Auction online: https://www.UUCWCauction@asimobile.net This link can also be found on the UUCWC website Auction page. It's good to pre-register, but registration will also be open through the auction from Saturday, May 1, at 9:00 am. to Saturday May 8 at 11:59 pm.

The registration process is simple. First, you must create a password and provide credit card information. At this time, UUCWC does not accept American Express. You may switch to a different card at the point of purchase. We are using a secure credit card processing service which will delete all your information after the end of the auction.

The Online Auction goes live May 1, 9:00 am. and runs through Saturday, May 8, 11:59 pm.

Special Feature: The Auction Online website highlights special items and also indicates items that are currently without any bids — you might be the lucky bidder! And keep your eye on the front page for updates. Note: If a fixed-price item is sold out, it will no longer appear for sale.

Online Categories: In addition to item numbers, you will be able to search items by categories such as Cultural, Dinners, Games/Sports, Home Accessories, Jewelry/Health/Beauty, Trips, and Workshops.

ONLINE BIDDING TIPS!

Getting the items you want may take some planning. Here are great tips from veterans.

Before the Auction:

- Pre-register so you are ready to purchase or bid when the online auction opens.
- Use your auction book (or the book PDF online) to plan ahead. Mark and prioritize the items for which you want to place a bid.
- Check your calendar in advance for dinner and event dates. There is a convenient list of all events by date in the back of the book.
- Use the online site to view the items in categories.

During the Auction:

• Watch the website for the most recent bids and items that are marked "No Bid."

Want to win a big item? Pull together a team and:

- Agree on your maximum bid.
- Designate one person to bid for your team.
- Pick one payer to settle the account.

After the Auction:

- On or shortly after the end of the auction (May 8) you will be notified via emails of your winning competitive bids and asked to confirm you purchases.
- If you win a meal, event or service, the Auction Team will mail or email your certificate(s) to you.
- The Auction Team will help to facilitate getting the physicals items from donor to winning bidder.




