You can take these steps now to prepare for the online auction:

NOTE: Even returning online auction users need to register as if for the first time! Simply create a password and provide credit card information. You'll be able to get a sneak peek at the items being offered along with photos or a graphic representation **for each one to help you make your decisions.**

2. Familiarize yourself with the three types of auction items:

- **Fixed Price (100s, 200s, 300s, 400s)**
Includes meals, events, custom foods, some physical items, and services. Purchase these items on the spot at the indicated price. ***You must pay for each item individually*** rather than filling up a "cart" with multiple items for a lump purchase.
- **Competitive (500s, 600s, 700s, 800s)**
Includes physical items, services, specialty food items, cultural memberships, gift cards, and exciting vacation rentals. Bid on these items, then check back throughout the week to see if you've been outbid, so you can enter a new bid. You will receive outbid announcements through the online auction system.
- **Live (900s)**
Includes a variety of handcrafted, unique items! Should an item not reach its minimum bid amount at the live auction on May 1, the item will be available for bidding in the online auction!

3. Select and prioritize the items you'd like to bid on or purchase, so you'll be ready when the auction goes live. And if you're teaming up with others to bid on a big-ticket item, designate one person to bid for your team.

You can bid or buy anytime beginning **Saturday, May 2, 9:00 am**, through **Saturday, May 9, 9:00 pm**. Grab your fixed-price items first, so you won't be disappointed, then bid on competitive items.

On the first day, please limit your purchase of meals in the 100s to 2.

Online Navigation Tips:

- The online site highlights special items and also indicates items that are currently without any bids — so you might be in luck! And keep your eye on the front page for updates.
- If a fixed-price item is sold out, it will no longer appear.
- In addition to searching by item number, you can search items by category such as Activities/Games, Getaways, Home Accessories, Health/Beauty, Jewelry, Music and Spirituality/Workshops.

- **For competitive bids**, you will be emailed a list of your winning bids from the Afrogs online auction system shortly after the close of the auction so you can confirm your bid/s and submit your payment.
- **For meals, events or services**, purchase certificates will be emailed to you by the Auction Team.
- **For physical items**, the Auction Team will help facilitate the transfer of the item from the donor to you. We anticipate being able to distribute on Sunday, May 17 after the service.

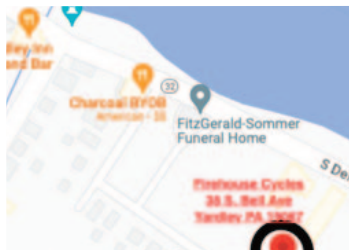
