Capital Projects Highlights

- Township approved parking project
- Parking contract awarded to Mizu Contracting and Landscape Design
- Parking Construction Project work initiated November 2018; projected cost \$110,000
- Architect contract awarded to David B. Singer
- Anticipate conceptual plans with preliminary pricing first quarter of 2019

Timeline

- 2016 UUCWC began a comprehensive strategic planning effort to ensure the continuing strength of the church in serving its ministries and members in the years ahead.
- 2017 A Strategic Visioning Task Force worked with consultant Andy Hamlin to draft and finalize a document articulating the proposed plans and associated cost estimates, yielding an estimated \$1.7 million in proposed renovations, repairs and improvements to the church facility and grounds.
- November 2017 -Tthe aspirational capital campaign goal of \$1,100,000 was decided upon.
- March 2018 The Capital Campaign kicked off together with the Annual Stewardship Drive
 - o Pledge payments range from 1-5 year financial commitments
- 2019 Once the architectural drawings are complete they will be sent out to engineers for bidding.
 - When we have pricing from engineers finalized we will review the needs list and prioritize projects accordingly.

Looking Ahead

Once the architect has presented us with completed plans, we will review and work to prioritize our needs and
accomplish as much as we can within the budget that we have pledged so far. The final plans will be sent out
for bid to contractors and also to the township for approvals. We do not anticipate breaking ground until fall
2019 or later.
